English

In English this half term, we are reading the book 'Traction Man' by Mini Grey.

We will be creating our own descriptions and using it to write a character profile. We will also be looking at the features of a comic strip and using this to support us in writing our own.

We will be practising our use of capital letters to start a sentence or a name as well as using full stops at the end of a sentence.

We will also be using simple conjunctions to add detail to our sentences and using expanded noun phrases to make our writing more descriptive.

Maths

In Maths this half term, we are learning about numbers to 100.

We will be looking at the different ways that numbers can be represented.

We will also be learning about all the different ways that we can complete addition and subtraction problems.

This half term we will be learning about the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Please do practise this at home!

TOPIC FOCUS: OCEAN EXPLORERS

This term our creative topic is 'Ocean explorers'. We will be learning the amazing routes of the Great Explorers and what they discovered on their travels. We will also be looking at the countries they travelled from, through and to. In DT, we will be making a boat to carry a piece of fruit across the water. In Science, we will be learning about different materials and their similarities and differences. We will also be using our investigative skills to test whether materials float or sink.

HOME LEARNING

We encourage you to read with your child at least 10 minutes every day. Please record the books your child reads in their reading champion book. There are lots of rewards for reading books at home so please do encourage your child to read as much as possible!

Children will be given weekly number facts and spelling homework, which they will then be tested on the following week. The children should become fluent and aim to answer each number fact question in under 5 seconds! They can earn certificates for scoring 40-44 over consecutive weeks.
