Reminders

TOPIC FOCUS: "STARRY NIGHT"

Our Creative topic this half term is 'Starry Starry Night'. We will be learning all about the history of space travel and the first Moon Landing. In Computing, we will be learning about coding using an app called code spark. In Art, we will be learning about Vincent Van Gogh and we will be recreating his famous painting 'Starry starry night' based on London. In Science, we will be learning about different materials and their properties. We will also be learning about natural and man-made resources. We will be investigating the properties of different materials.

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English


In English we will be learning about the story 'Beegu' and we will be writing our own alien stories! We will learn to use features such as time openers and descriptive phrases. Then, we will be looking at the story 'Look Up'. We will be exploring the characters and events. We will also learn about the first black woman in space called Mae Jemison.

ONLINE SAFETY

Talk to your child about how the Internet can be used to find information- you can use it to find out about pretty much anything! Explain to your child that it can sometimes be dangerous and we need to make sure we know how to stay safe on the Internet.

Maths

In our Maths lessons, we will be exploring number equations and beginning to add and subtract. We will be learning about numbers 10-20 in detail. Children will be able to confidently count and write to 20 and understand place value within these numbers. They will compare and order numbers and be able to spot patterns within 20. We will also look at 2D and 3D shapes and patterns.



HOME LEARNING

We encourage you to read with your child **every day** for 10 - 15 minutes and make comments in their blue Reading Champions books. Books will be changed weekly.

There are lots of rewards for reading books at home so please do encourage your child to read as much as possible!
