IMPORTANT INFORMATION

English

In English this half term, we will be looking more closely at a variety of stunning Turner paintings and then using these pictures as a stimulus for our discussions in class and some fantastic descriptive writing.

As well as this, we will be learning how to use adjectives and similes to add more description to our writing to make our writing more interesting and exciting.

Also we will be linking our writing in with our geography learning and we will be listening to and reading poems about weather. Then we will be using these poems as inspiration for writing our own poems.

Maths

In Maths this half term we are learning about multiplication and division.

For multiplication, we will be looking at groups of objects and finding out how many groups there are and how many objects there are in each group.

For division we will be finding out how to share or group objects equally.

This half term we will be learning the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Please do practise this at home!

TOPIC FOCUS: TERRIFIC TURNER

This half term we will be learning about Terrific Turner! We will be looking at his famous artwork and finding out lots of fascinating information about him. In Geography, we will be learning all about the four countries that make up Great Britain. We will be exploring the human and physical features found in each country, including major towns and cities. For Science, our learning will focus on what it means to be a living thing. In addition, we will be learning about habitats and why different animals need to live in certain environments.

HOME LEARNING

We encourage you to read with your child at least 10 minutes every day. Please record the books your child reads in their reading champion book. There are lots of rewards for reading books at home so please do encourage your child to read as much as possible!

Children will be given weekly number facts and spelling homework, which they will then be tested on the following week. The children should become fluent and aim to answer each number fact question in under 5 seconds! They can earn certificates for scoring 40-44 over consecutive weeks.
